BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the financing and construction of the Project by the Fountain County Building Corporation ("Corporation") and the leasing of same to the County is in the public interest of the citizens of the County and it is a proper public purpose for which the County Council agrees to cooperate with the Corporation to assist in fulfilling the requirements of all agencies of the federal, state and county government.
